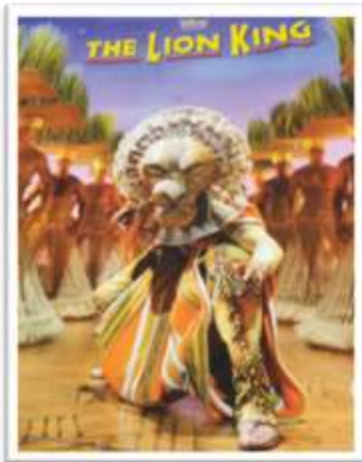
## NATIONAL TRENDS
